Public Service Employee (PSE)-Electrical Technician

San Bernardino County Special Districts Department is recruiting for the classification of PSE-Electrical Technician. This position works under close supervision performing a variety of assignments related to the operations, maintenance, repair and inspection of water and wastewater electrical and telemetry systems within the Special Districts Department. The position may be assigned to any of the work locations throughout the County. Duties include but are not limited to the following:

- Works from prints and plans and makes mathematical computations used in planning and installing electrical circuits, pull boxes, switches, transformers and signaling systems.
- Repairs and replaces broken or defective parts in motors, generators, relays, storage batteries, controllers, switches, fixtures, solar equipment and panel boards and other specialized electrical and telemetry systems.
- Tests, locates and repairs trouble in electrical circuits and equipment; plans electrical installations.
- Installs sensors, wiring, antenna cabling, and RTU equipment for telemetry systems.
- Maintains and adjusts electrical controls and motors including pump settings, belt presses, generators, transfer switches electrical panels, components and related equipment.
- Repairs and maintains hydraulic and mechanical control systems.
- Organizes and maintains a comprehensive record and file system including notations of dates, readings, repairs, maintenance completed and future work required. Submits requests for supplies, parts and materials and maintains necessary inventory.
- Responds to emergency calls on a 24-hour basis. Performs "On Call" duties with a 1-hour or less response time. On-Call duties are performed in all weather conditions including inclement weather.

SALARY AND BENEFITS:

Salary: \$18.00-\$25.00 per hour. This position has no benefits associated with it other than the County's PST Deferred Compensation Plan.

The Requirements:

Must have a minimum of five years experience in electrical maintenance and repair. Must possess a valid class "C" California Driver's License. Must be available to work evenings, weekends, and holidays. All new employees must adhere to the provisions of the County Fire and Special Districts Dress Code, which prohibits all visible tattoos.
