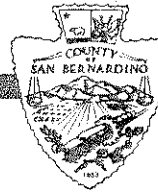

Dear Resident of CSA 70, M Wonder Valley:

A committee has formed in your area to address road maintenance. We have decided to send this information sheet and customer satisfaction survey to provide information to the community about your current road service and to obtain information about the level of satisfaction with the roads. CSA 70 M employs a part time equipment operator who grades the roads two days per week for eight and a half hours per day after travel time and daily servicing of equipment. The road grading procedure is that the operator makes an average two to four passes on each road utilizing the road drag based on the amount of wash boarding on the roadway. If the road is really rough, he will use the road grader blade. The reason we drag the roads instead of using the blade is to reduce the decomposition of the roadway and exposing utility lines.

Roads in the area have been designated as primary, secondary and low use roads. The primary roads are graded approximately every two to four weeks depending on use or weather, the secondary roads are graded every four to six weeks and low use roads are graded on a by-request basis. Listed below are the emergency roads, primary roads and secondary roads. If your road is not listed, it has been designated as a low use road. There are approximately 247 low use roads. This procedure has been developed in order to maximize the frequency of the road grading on the primary roads in the area while saving costs and operating within the district budget of \$70,000 per year. If all the roads were done on an equal basis each road would be graded approximately one time per year.

When there is a flash flood condition all efforts are used to open up the emergency and damaged roads. The emergency use roads are opened first. Once those roads are completed the regular grading schedule is resumed.
