Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino, California, will receive sealed bids on or before **May 7, 2008** at the hour of 2:00 p.m., at the offices of the Special Districts Department, 157 West Fifth Street, Second Floor, San Bernardino California, 92415, at which time they will be publicly opened and declared for the construction of the proposed park improvements which include: playground equipment, picnic shelters, walkways, irrigation, landscaping, parking lot rehabilitation, public restroom facility and other improvements, for County Service Area 63 in accordance with the plans, specifications, and other contract documents now on file in the Special Districts Department.

**SCOPE OF WORK:**

The work includes, but is not limited to providing all necessary materials, labor, equipment, tools, transportation and services to construct substantial park improvements, including new playground equipment and fall zone surfacing, new picnic shelters and handicap walkways, landscape and irrigation improvements, parking lot rehabilitation, public restroom facility and other improvements in accordance with the plans and specifications as provided by Community Works Design Group.

**REQUIREMENTS:**

Each bid shall be in accordance with the plans, specifications, and other contract documents, copies of which may be obtained from the Special Districts Department, Telephone No. (909) 387-5940. Cost for plans and specifications are \$45.00 non-refundable to cover printing and duplication charges. Plans and specifications will be mailed out upon request if accompanied by check or money order or may be Fed Ex'd provided that bidder supplies own FED-X account number.

Bids shall be prepared on forms obtained from the said office, and must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bidder's bond issued by a surety company accredited by the owner, for not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid, made payable to the order of the County of San Bernardino, Special Districts Department, given as a guarantee the bidder will enter into contract within ten (10) days after being requested to do so by the district.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a labor and material bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price, and a faithful performance bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price, said bonds to be secured from a surety company licensed to sell surety contracts in the State of California and satisfactory to the district.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date set for the opening thereof. Bidders may submit with their bids, a sworn statement of their financial responsibility, technical ability and experience. Such sworn statement may be required before award is made to any particular bidder.

Contractor may, upon written request, and at their expense after approval by the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Bernardino, deposit substitute securities found in Government Code Section 16430, as authorized by Public Contract Code 22300, in lieu of retention monies withheld to insure performance.

Pursuant to the statutes of the State of California, the Board of Supervisors has ascertained the general prevailing rate of wages and rates for legal holiday and overtime work in the locality in which the work is to be performed. Said prevalent rates of wage shall conform to the most recent rates published by the Director of California Department of Industrial Relations. Said rates are included in this set and on file at the Special Districts Department, 157 West Fifth Street, Second Floor, San Bernardino, California, 92415.

The Board of Supervisors acting as the governing body of County Service Area 63 reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive technical errors and discrepancies and/or to waive any informality of a bid not affected by law, if to do so seems to best serve the public interest.

The Contractor, in order to qualify for award of the contract shall possess and maintain at a minimum California Class "B" or C-8, C-12 or C-27 license at the time of the scheduled bid opening for this contract. The Contractor shall have been engaged in similar park improvement projects for a period of not less than 5 years.
